He has completed 50 major Jewish community studies for Jewish Federations throughout the country and is currently working on a study of the impact of Covid-19 for UJA-Federation of NY. He has also been a consultant to numerous synagogues, Jewish day schools, Jewish agencies, Jewish nursing homes, and Jewish Community Centers throughout the country. In addition, he is the author of numerous articles on Jewish demography, the Jewish vote, and related topics.
